Professor Joseph Sifakis studied Electrical-Mechanical Engineering at the National Technical University of Athens and Computer Science at the University of Grenoble, France.

He is considered to be one of the top international scientists working in the field of informatics. In 2007 he received the Turing Award, which is considered to be information technology's equivalent to the Nobel Prize.

He has received numerous awards and prizes. He is a member of the French Academy of Sciences, the French Academy of Technologies, the Academia Europea, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the National Academy of Engineering and the Chinese Academy of Sciences.

In 2009, the French Republic awarded him the title of the Grand Officer of the Order of Merit (Grand Officier de l'Ordre du Merite) and the title of Commander of the Legion of Honor (Commandant de la Legion d'Honneur) in 2011.

In 2009, he received the Award of the Hellenic Parliament Foundation for Parliamentarism and Democracy. He was awarded Commander of the Greek Order of the Phoenix in 2013. In 2012, he received the Leonardo Da Vinci Medal.

Joseph Sifakis was President of the Greek National Council for Research and Technology from February 2014 to April 2016.
